All clinical psychology graduate students receive a graduate assistantship that may carry an expectation of up to 20 hours/week of work (e.g., as a teaching assistant or research assistant), renewable for up to four years: that is, all students receive an average stipend of \$13,000/year for the first four years of their graduate education. In addition, students receive a full tuition waiver for up to five years and health insurance coverage. We expect that these programs will continue, unless the state funding picture changes significantly. However, students are responsible for paying the university fees.
